The conference will take place in Nish, place of birth of Constantine the Great, Emperor of Rome (c. 272-337 AD) distinguished, in particular, for his contribution to the development of Christianity. Within the scope of 150 km from Nish, there are birth places of two other important emperors of Rome – Galerius (260-311 AD) and Justinian I (c. 482-565 AD), among 18 all together, born on territory of nowadays Serbia. Galerius's birth place, Romuliana near Gamzigrad, is UNESCO World Heritage Site.

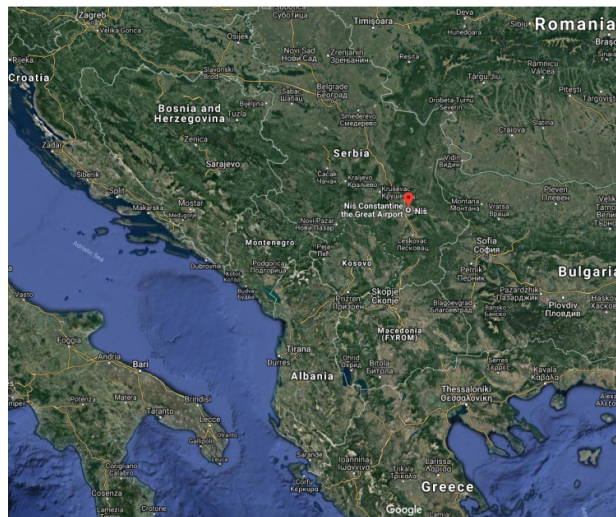
